



# MOBILE MAN ANCHOR INSTALLATION GUIDE



## STAGE 1

Always check the suitability of the roof before using the system. The roof surface should be clear, brush away loose chippings or debris, in a 2.5 metre square.

**DO NOT** place on icy or slippery surfaces.  
**DO NOT** use on roof surfaces under 2.5 metres high.

## STAGE 2

Place the spine at the desired position on the surface, make sure that it is not less than 2 metres from an unprotected edge. Ensure lanyards are prevented from fraying on the apex of the roof.



## STAGE 3

Position the base beside the spine.



## STAGE 4

Insert the joining arms through the sleeves on the body and spine.

### Important Information

The Mobile Man Anchor is only to be used in conjunction with tested and approved harnesses and inertia block/energy absorbers and only to be used by ONE person at any one time. The Man Anchor has been tested in wet conditions on profile cladding, PVC membrane, mineral felt, asphalt, concrete slabs (pebble finish), stone sweepings (granite and chips).

**After extensive tests it was found that single ply PVC membrane did not provide sufficient friction to arrest a fall in WET conditions and therefore DO NOT use on single ply membrane in wet conditions.**

## STAGE 5

Tighten all the T keys to secure the system, the system is now ready for use.
